Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers,

Further Confirmed case of Covid-19 in Year 4

A further confirmed case of COVID-19 (coronavirus) has been reported to school today for a Year 4 child. This child is asymptomatic (has no symptoms) and is now self-isolating.

Please note the following:

- In line with current government guidance, the Year 4 class remains open and your Year 4 child can continue to attend school as normal, providing they stay well.
- I would strongly advise all Year 4 parents/carers to arrange a PCR test for their child (if they have not already done so) regardless of whether they have symptoms. Children can continue to attend school whilst waiting for PCR results, providing they have no Covid symptoms.
- In our experience, results from a test taken at a walk-in or drive-through test site are returned more quickly than those from a postal test.
- Please be vigilant in monitoring your child for any Covid symptoms, however mild.
- Should your child test positive for Covid, please remember to email (or telephone) the school office straight away at sao@meridian.greenwich.sch.uk (Tel: 020 8858 3572). The school email address is monitored outside of school hours for Covid notifications.
- All children who are self-isolating for Covid related reasons are set remote home learning via Google Classroom.

Whilst we know that parents/carers may find this news worrying, we will continue to work closely with the Royal Borough of Greenwich (RBG) and Public Health England (PHE) to monitor the situation. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus will be a mild illness.

Further information for parents

How do I arrange a PCR test for my child?

You can arrange for your child to have a PCR test whether or not they have symptoms by following this link: [Ask for a coronavirus test](#). Alternatively, you can call 119. If your child has no symptoms, they can continue to attend school whilst awaiting their PCR result.

Please inform us straight away of a positive test result by emailing sao@meridian.greenwich.sch.uk or telephoning the school on 020 8858 3572. The school email address is monitored outside of school hours for Covid notifications.

What are the symptoms of Covid-19?

The [Main symptoms of coronavirus \(COVID-19\)](#) are:

- **a high temperature** - this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **a new, continuous cough** - this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- **a loss or change to sense of smell or taste** - this means you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

What should I do if my child develops one or more symptoms of COVID-19?

If your child has **any one** of the above Covid symptoms, however mild, they should stay at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appear and arrange a PCR test.
